We are also looking for some new Hunters Safety instructors If interested please get ahold of John Glover or Randy Rice. Thank You.

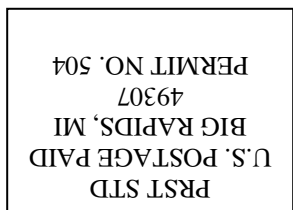
CLEAN UP DAY
