HUNTERS SAFETY

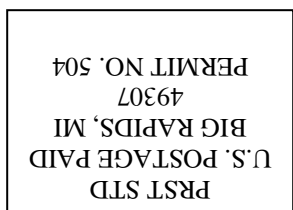
